## Do you know what goes in the BLUE BIN?

Confused about what you should put in your blue recycling cart at home? Here are some tips and a helpful graphic showing what is recyclable in your blue bin at home. Questions? Give us a call at 707-963-7988.

- Place all recyclable items loose in the cart.
- Items outside the cart will not be picked up.
- Do not bind or bundle any items.
- Flatten all cardboard boxes and place them in your cart.
- No food or liquids – keep your recyclables empty, clean and dry!
- Roll out your blue recycling cart only when it is more than half full. It's more efficient and saves time, energy and resources for everyone!
