Recycling Drop Off at Clover Flat



Drop off recycling is open for all
residents in Upper Napa Valley:

Items that can be recycled at Clover Flat Landfill FOR FREE:

- Motor Oil and Filters
- Cooking Oil
- Batteries
- Light bulbs and tubes
- Paintcare products with labels on
- E-waste
- Sharps
- Paper & cardboard
- Bottles & cans
- Mattresses (there are fees for commercial mattresses)

Items that can be recycled for
a fee (check the website for
current price):

- White Metal Appliances
- Freon Removal
- Vehicle and Tractor Tires

Recycling your Cardboard boxes?

Follow these rules:

- Break down and flatten your boxes
- Removing excess tape and any staples
- Cut box into pieces so it slides out of the cart easily when serviced



How to keep your cart clean!

All it takes is a little bit of planning. Simply layer your cart with yard waste and food waste to help it stay fresh. This will help lessen odors, deter pests, and keep from material becoming stuck. Adding newspaper and food-soiled paper keeps the cart even dryer!



Include the Food! It's as Easy as 1-2-3

- EVERY MEAL: put food scraps in the kitchen pail
- EVERY DAY: empty the pail (and the compostable bag) into the green compost cart
- EVERY WEEK: roll your cart out to the roadside for collection.
